

**The Ramuz Trophy 2015 - the NSBA InterClub Championship, open to  
Affiliated Organisations of the NSBA  
Royal Norfolk & Suffolk Yacht Club, Sunday 6th September 2015**

**NOTICE OF RACE**

1. The event is organized by Royal Norfolk & Suffolk Yacht Club (RN&SYC) in conjunction with the Norfolk and Suffolk Boating Association. It will be sailed in Broads One Designs provided by the organizing authority on the sea off Lowestoft. A representative of the boat's owner will sail in each boat
2. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
3. Entry is open to any organisation affiliated to the NSBA, to comprise a team of two persons to form the helm and crew. To enter, all parts of the form at the bottom of this page must be completed and signed by a representative of the affiliated organisation making the entry and lodged by **20<sup>th</sup> August 2015**. Early entries from Clubs are being encouraged. .
4. There will be a briefing which all competitors must attend, at 10:00 on the day in the Yacht Club. Sailing instructions will be provided at the briefing. The first race will start at 10.45 hrs.
5. There will be a qualifying series of four fleet races in which each team will race twice in boats allocated by the organizing authority (the allocation changing from race to race). There will be no discard. The leading six teams at the end of the qualifying series will compete in a final race which will determine the event result (no qualifying score being carried forward to the final). However, in the event of a final race not being completed, the winner of the trophy will be determined by the race committee based on points and highest winning margin in the heats.
6. All competitors shall provide their own personal flotation devices, which shall be worn at all times when afloat.
7. Under RRS 70.5(a), the right of appeal from protest and redress decisions related to the qualifying series is denied.
8. The sailing instructions will replace the one-turn and two-turn penalties in rule 44.1 with a time penalty that can be accepted at the time of an incident.
9. The Ramuz Trophy will be presented to the winning team after the final race, and commemorative glasses, suitably engraved, will be awarded to all finalists.
10. Drinks and hot buffet will be available in the Yacht Club
11. RN&SYC are pleased to welcome guests and spectators but please note that No Dogs are allowed at the Club and no wet clothes in the club house - there is a side entrance into the changing rooms.  
All non-members/guests should be signed into the guestbook. The Commodore will arrange this if you provide a list of visitors from your Club to the organisers, prior to the event.
