

**The Ramuz Trophy 2018 - the NSBA InterClub Championship, open to Affiliated Organisations of the NSBA
Norwich Frostbites Sailing Club, Saturday 20th October 2018**

NOTICE OF RACE

1. The event is organized by Norwich Frostbite Sailing Club (NFSC) in conjunction with the Norfolk and Suffolk Boating Association. It will be sailed in Norfolk One Design Dinghies provided by the organizing authority on the river Yare at Thorpe St Andrew, Norwich.
2. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
3. Entry is open to any organisation affiliated to the NSBA, to comprise a team of two persons to form the helm and crew. To enter, all parts of the form at the bottom of this page must be completed and signed by a representative of the affiliated organisation making the entry and lodged by 3rd October 2018.
4. There will be a briefing which all competitors must attend, at 10:30 on the day in the NFSC Club House. Sailing instructions will be provided at the briefing. The first warning signal is intended to be made at 11:25 hrs.
5. There will be a qualifying series of four fleet races in which each team will race twice in boats allocated by the organizing authority (the allocation changing from race to race). There will be no discard. The leading six teams at the end of the qualifying series will compete in a final race which will determine the event result (no qualifying score being carried forward to the final).
6. All competitors shall provide their own personal flotation devices, which shall be worn at all times when afloat.
7. *Under RRS 70.5(a), the right of appeal from protest and redress decisions related to the qualifying series is denied.*
8. The sailing instructions will replace the one-turn and two-turns penalties in rule 44.1 with a time penalty that can be accepted at the time of an incident.
9. The Ramuz Trophy will be presented to the winning team after the final race, and commemorative glasses, suitably engraved, will be awarded to all finalists.
10. Food and Drinks will be available in the Club House.
11. All competitor and visitors should park in the NFSC Car Park, which is off Girlings Lane, opposite the Oaks Bar & Hotel on Thorpe Road, Norwich. Great care must be taken walking across the railway line to the Club and river. See www.norwichfrostbitesailing.club/pages/where-are-we.html
